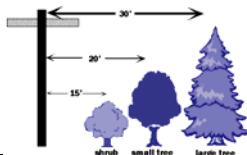


LANDSCAPE PLANT SIZES AND SPACING SUGGESTIONS



Trees	Height at Maturity	Spacing Between Trees (minimum suggested)	Tree Minimum Distance from Sidewalks or Driveways
Small	20' or less	15'	2'
Medium	20' to 40'	30'	4'
Large	40' +	40'	6'

Shrubs	Spread at Maturity	Spacing Between Plants (minimum suggested)	Spacing from Walls
Small	4' or less	3'	2 ½'
Medium	4' to 6'	4'	3'
Large	6' or more	5'	3'

Windbreaks Trees

Windbreak Trees	Single Row Spacing	Double Row Spacing	Distance Between Rows
Oriental Arborvitae	8'	10'	16'
Eastern Redcedar	12' to 15'	15'	20'
Deciduous Trees	10' to 20'	10' to 20'	16' to 20'

Tree Spacing in Special Areas

Trees	Minimum Spacing from Buildings	Minimum Spacing from Sewer Lines and Tanks	Minimum Spacing From Overhead Utility Lines
Small	10'	20'	OK for Under Utility Lines
Medium	15'	30'	20'
Large	20'	35'	30'
